STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students will follow these guidelines:

Neatness, proper dress, and good grooming are part of good behavior; inappropriate attire and grooming are not conducive to the general decorum within the school. In an administrator's judgement, anything that creates a distraction in the classroom is unacceptable. Parents will be called for a student change of clothes, as deemed necessary.

GENERAL

Clothing must cover all areas from one armpit across to the other armpit and down to fingertip length.

- Jeans/pants: No holes, shreds, or cuts.
- Shorts/Skirts/Skorts/Dresses:
 - No shorter than fingertip length.
 - No shorts with leggings.
 - No rolling of waistbands.
 - Swim-trunks, boxers, or pajama bottoms may not be worn as shorts.
- Underwear and undergarments should never be visible including camis, tanks, sport bras, bras, bralettes, or in the case of boys, boxer briefs or compression pants.
- Crop tops are not permitted.
- Hoodie hoods may not be worn over the head inside the building.
- Body piercing jewelry is not permitted. Girls may wear earrings.
- Slides, flip flops, house shoes, shower shoes, and slippers are not to be worn at school.
- Obscene/vulgar language or inappropriate pictures are not allowed on clothing/jewelry.
- Advertisements or promotion of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, etc. is prohibited.
- Satanic, cult, or gang-related symbolism in any form is prohibited.
- Clothing may not state, imply, or depict hate speech/imagery targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, religious affiliation, or any other protected classification.
- Caps, hats, sunglasses, and pajama pants may only be worn on designated spirit days.

Girls:

- Tops must have full shoulder straps and/or sleeves. Shoulder straps must have a width of 3".
- Tank tops are not permitted.
- Modest necklines are required.
- Leggings: Must be worn with a shirt meeting the length requirement of fingertip length.

Boys:

- Must have sleeves.
- Tank tops and sleeveless shirts are not permitted.
- Leggings are not permitted.

AIRPODS OR GAMING HEADPHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPUS.

Administration or faculty designee has the final interpretation on appropriateness of any clothing. Privileges may be revoked at any time. Repeat dress code violations may result in suspension of these particular policies.

Dress Code Violation Procedures:

First Offense: Warning and/or parent

contact for change

of clothes.

Second Offense: Parent contact for change

of clothes and warning of loss of

privilege.

Third Offense: Parent contact for change of clothes and

loss of privilege.

Fourth Offense: Saturday Seminar

Students in violation of dress code will be sent to the office. Administration will be the final interpreter of the violation. **If you have doubt about your clothing meeting the dress code, do not wear it to school.**
